Whether you are looking to refine your technique or expand your repertoire, this course provides a unique opportunity to practice a wide range of procedures on a complete specimen, including:

- Tympanoplasty
- Cholesteatoma surgery
- Cochlear implantation
- Bone conduction implants
- Radical cavity reconstruction
- Stapes surgery
- Lateral skull base surgery
- Lateral temporal bone resection

*Each day will combine practical dissection sessions of whole head specimens with concise lectures and instructional demonstrations. Every instructor will deliver a focused 30-minute lecture, complemented by short dissection briefings at the start of each session.*

**Course Language:** English

**Target Audience:** ENT surgeons from the Nordic countries. Initially, three spots are reserved per country. Additional participants may be considered based on demand.
